Grounding of a Bulk Carrier (No.2)

Kawasaki Kisen Kaisha, Ltd. ("K" Line) reports that the "MERCURY OCEAN", a bulk carrier went aground off Boshnyakovo Port, Russia, refloated at 22:00(Local Time) on October 30 and safely shifted to anchorage. According to the Head Owners, all the crew is safe, and no pollution has been observed until now.

The Head Owners is working closely with relevant authorities and taking safety measures.

"K" Line will continue to strengthen safety in navigation and enhance its quality with all relevant parties including shipowners through close cooperation and communication.
